Join colleagues and friends for a fun, educational trip to Washington DC and the United Methodist Building. This seminar will focus **on gun violence prevention in the United States.**

Gun violence continues to be a problem in the United States. The CDC reported in 2020 that deaths related to firearms, overtook deaths related to motor vehicle crashes, to become the leading cause of deaths for children 1-19 years of age. Amnesty International reports that in 2022, there were 45,222 gun deaths in the United States. Higher, per capita, than any other industrialized country in the world. While mass shootings and assassination attempts capture the media's attention, gun violence deaths happen on a smaller scale every day. According to the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, in Pennsylvania in 2021 there were 2,326 hospitalizations due to firearms injury.
